## The Who, What, When, Where, Why and How of Missions

### Romans 10:9-15

9 If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. 11 As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.” 12 For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, 13 for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

14 How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? 15 And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

### Who

- Those that need to HEAR so that they may BELIEVE on The Lord Jesus, CALL on His name and CONFESS Him as Lord and Savior (According to our passage in Romans 10)
- The Lost

### Luke 19:10

10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.” *(at Zacchaeus' home)*

- Those who have wandered away

I think that it was not by accident that we spent the last month studying the parable of the Prodigal Son along with the other parables of Luke 15

- Those who have never heard the name of Jesus
- Unreached People Groups, people who have no access to The Gospel

## What

- Blessed are the feet of those who bring good news

1 Chronicles 16:24

24 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples.

- We are all called to be Missionaries of the Gospel but we are not all called to be set apart and solely dedicated to the Work of Missions

John 20:21

21 Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

Acts 13:1-3

13 1 Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul. 2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3 So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off.

- It seems to involve being called, being set apart, being sent, going, preaching the good news
- We need to have some serious conversations
- Not everything is Missions

## When

- Now until Jesus comes

John 4:35

35 Don't you have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.

- We must maintain a sense of urgency in getting the gospel message out

1 Thessalonians 5:2

2 for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night.

- Now is the time

2 Corinthians 6:2

2 ..I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.

- Work while it is day

John 9:4

4 As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work.
